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All AI Coordinators for SSC and Intermediate (TOSS) are hereby informed about the comprehensive guidelines and schedule for the payment of examination fees for the Telangana Open School Society SSC & Intermediate exams in **March/April- 2026**. **They are requested to disseminate this information to learners who intend to participate in the SSC and Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations scheduled for March/April, 2026.** Payments can be made directly through the official website www.telanganaopenschool.org or at Meeseva/TG Online centers in the state.

The examinations are tentatively scheduled to take place in March/April 2026. AI coordinators are requested to share this information with learners and advise them to regularly check the TOSS official website for updates and to download the detailed examination schedule.

1. Learners meeting the criteria specified below are eligible to participate in the Intermediate and SSC (TOSS) Public Examination in March/April- 2026.

- i.Students registered during the academic year 2025-26,
- ii.Students enrolled in previous years who participated in exams but did not pass,
- iii.Students enrolled in previous years who did not appear for exams.

Note: Learners have the opportunity to complete their subjects/courses within 5 years of admission or nine attempts, whichever comes earlier.

4. Eligibility to appear Examinations:

Learners enrolled in SSC & Intermediate (TOSS) courses for the academic year 2025-26, and who previously failed (**5 years of admission or nine attempts, whichever comes earlier**) will be allowed to participate in the SSC & Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations in **March/April- 2026**. The Learners appearing for Intermediate /SSC (TOSS) Public Examinations are classified as follows:

Cat	Details
1	Learners enrolled online in the academic year 2025-26, signifying new admissions, fall under Category-I.
2	Learners enrolled in prior years, namely 2020-21, 2021-22 , 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25 who participated in SSC/Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations but did not succeed, fall under Category-II.
3	Learners admitted during previous academic years i.e., 2020-21, 2021-22 , 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25 and appeared for SSC/Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations for the first time are treated as Category-III
4	Learners admitted during academic year 2025-26 (fresh admissions of this academic year) but having only one year gap after passing SSC and are eligible to appear to a maximum of 4 subjects only, treated as Category-IV (For Intermediate only)
5	Learners who have appeared for SSC/Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations and passed in some subjects and failed in some subjects and desire to improve their performance in any passed subjects are treated as Category-5.
6	Learners who have passed (all subjects) SSC/Intermediate (TOSS) Public

	Examinations and desire to improve their performance by canceling their previous performance. The latest performance holds good either pass or fail. The original pass certificate and Migration cum Transfer Certificate of TOSS shall be surrendered to TOSS along with the candidate's undertaking.
7	Failed Learners of Category-5 who have already availed of the improvement chance. They are not allowed to avail of improvement chances in the future.
8	Failed in 6 th subject (additional subject) and passed in all the main five subjects and a pass certificate was also issued to the candidates. These Learners are allowed to appear only for the 6 th subject and the other main five subjects codes will be kept blank.

Note: An asterisk (*) in the ENR column beside a subject code indicates that the candidate has successfully passed in that subject and is exempt from appearing for the examination. Only the subjects in which the candidate was unsuccessful are eligible for selection (to appear in the examination). The total number of failed papers is specified under the heading **SUB. CNT** (Subject Count).

5. PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED LEARNERS (PH):

The following displays the categorization of PH Learners in Intermediate & SSC (TOSS).

AI coordinators **must use 'RED INK' to indicate the disability category for each learner** upon verifying the original certificate issued by the **competent authority against the learner's name**. They are required to submit a photocopy of the certificate, issued by specified authorities for PH Learners admitted in the academic year 2025-26, to the District Educational Officer along with the Fee paid list. The submission should include the enclosed proforma (**Application form & Annexure-I(a), I(b)**), **duly attested by the respective District Educational Officer. Failure to provide a duly attested photocopy of the Medical Certificate by the DEO will lead to the cancellation of exemptions/concessions under the PH category, and the candidate will be treated as a general candidate.**

Note:

- a. As per Government Order G.O. Ms. No.5 dated 13.06.2018 from the WCD & SC (Schemes) department and G.O. Ms. No.31 dated 01.12.2009 from the WDCW & DW department, the Disability Certificate should be issued by Government Hospitals operating under the jurisdiction of either the Central or State Governments, with the endorsement of the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent.

- b. Learners with Special Needs (CwSN) intending to take the **Intermediate Public Examinations** organized by the Telangana Open School Society and seeking **exemptions or concessions as per the proceedings of the Secretary, Board of Intermediate Education Telangana Rc. No 81/E2-3/2010-11, Dated 08-04-2011** must submit a **request application** through their Institution Head along with the ENR. The application, accompanied by a Xerox copy of the medical certificate attested by the respective District Education Officer, should be forwarded by the Head of the Institute.
- c. Learners with Special Needs (CwSN) intending to take the **SSC Public Examinations** organized by the Telangana Open School Society and seeking **exemptions or concessions as per the GO Ms No 27 SE (Prog II) Dept Dated 07-11-2022** must submit a **request application** through their Institution Head along with the ENR. The application, accompanied by a Xerox copy of the medical certificate attested by the respective District Education Officer, should be forwarded by the Head of the Institute. **Only Learners whose disability category is properly recorded in the TOSS Intermediate /SSC Public Examinations application form will be considered for exemptions or concessions, as per their eligibility.**

6. TRANSFER OF CREDITS LEARNERS (TOC) (Refer Prospectus 2025-26 ,Section 2.4 (a) (b) (c):

The AI Coordinators are requested to submit the **SSC/Intermediate original failed marks memos** (i.e., **Regular stream SSC/Intermediate failed Learners memo**) submitted by the Learners who are admitted in the academic year **2025-26** and opted for TOC to the District Educational Officers concerned **on or before 12 .01.2026** along with enclosed proforma (**Annexure-II(a), II(b)**) **to this office through DEO concerned**. Failure to submit the original certificate entails the cancellation of the TOC facility.

7. SIXTH ADDITIONAL SUBJECT:

Learners who opt for the 6th Additional subject at the time of admission will be displayed separately in the ENR under the heading '**6th SUB.**' The performance in the 6th Additional subject, whether pass or fail, will not affect the passing status in the chosen five subjects. However, learners failing in any of the selected five subjects will be deemed unsuccessful, irrespective of their performance in the 6th subject.

The 2025-26 academic year results for M.Bi.P.C. Learners will be determined by their performance in three optional subjects (Biology, Physics, and Chemistry) and two language subjects only. Mathematics will only be regarded as an additional subject. If a learner opts for **Mathematics** instead of **Biology** as an additional subject, they must submit an undertaking to the AI Coordinator. The AI Coordinator, in turn, is required to submit it to the State office by mail.

8. IMPROVEMENT OF PERFORMANCE:

Learners have the option to enhance their previous performance if they have successfully passed all subjects (i.e., certificate holder). However, they are required to surrender the original pass certificate and Migration-cum-Transfer Certificate. The marks from the latest performance **will be considered valid** only if the candidate has passed, improved, or failed. Additionally, besides paying examination fees for all subjects, including practical papers if applicable, such learners must also submit the following.

- i. Original SSC / Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examination Pass Certificate
- ii. Original Migration cum Transfer Certificate

- iii. Undertaking in Annexure-III(c) for the annulment of prior performance and confirmation of acceptance of the present performance (Pass or Fail)

Note:

- The online hosting of ENRs for pass certificate holders is unavailable. Consequently, AI-Coordination are required to create Manuscript Nominal Rolls (MNRs) specifically for learners opting to enhance their performance (Category-6). These MNRs, accompanied by the original pass certificates, should be submitted (III (a) & (b) to the State Office through the District Educational Officer concerned .
- Learners who have failed in certain subjects but passed in others are allowed to enhance their performance in the subjects they passed initially. However, this opportunity for improvement is limited to a single occurrence within the candidate's tenure of 5 years or 9 examinations, whichever comes first, until they successfully pass all subjects. Learners pursuing improvement fall under Category 5.
- Learners who have passed all subjects but wish to pursue improvement within one year of course completion must participate in all papers, including both theory and practical components. Further, learners should have agreed to nullify their earlier performance. They are granted a maximum of two chances during this period, and they are required to forfeit their previous performance in the passed papers.

9. MALPRACTICE CASES:

The Learners who are involved in Malpractice (under Item-I) in SSC/Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations, September-2025, and permitted appearing for the SSC/Intermediate (TOSS) Public Examinations, in March/April 2026 are included in the ENR duly canceling their performance of September-2025. Hence, these Learners have to appear for all such subjects. The ENRs of the Learners who were involved in Malpractice in earlier examinations and eligible as per the punishment orders issued by this office to appear for March/April 2026 are also included in ENR.

10. Tentative Subject Combinations for SSC & Intermediate, March/April 2026: AI coordinators are requested to guide learners to review the subject combinations scheduled for each day before paying the examination fee. If a learner finds a clash with more than one subject scheduled in the same session on a particular day, they should inform the District Coordinator in writing after paying the examination fee, but before the final date prescribed for the Rs. 25/- penalty.

11. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- i. ENRs will be hoisted on the TOSS Website www.telanganaopenschool.org.
- ii. AI Coordinators are advised to guide learners in submitting the examination fee, as specified in item 3 of this letter, via the TOSS website or through Mee-seva/TS Online centers. **Further, it is recommended to ensure that learners do not pay an amount exceeding the prescribed fee.**
- iii. AI coordinators must thoroughly read the instructions provided in **Section 2.8 of the Admissions Prospectus 2025-26** and provide guidance to learners when submitting examination fees to prevent additional difficulties.
- iv. AI Coordinators are requested to help learners review their details in the ENR **when paying the examination fee**. The ENR is generated from the final admission data, encompassing subjects (Practicals/Theory), Medium, Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name, **Spacing** between names, Date of Birth, etc. **Recommend Learners to cross-check this information with their online admission records.** In case of any corrections needed, learners should submit a separate request letter via the AI, accompanied by supporting documents, for additional scrutiny by the State office.

Note : The AI Coordinator/Learner must exercise caution when making corrections/requests to names and ensure that they do not entirely alter the original name or identity. Specifically, they are not permitted to change complete names or make modifications that result in a name significantly different from the original. Such changes may lead to a distinct identity that deviates from the original intent or record, which is strictly prohibited. Minor corrections are only allowed if they align closely with the original name and do not compromise its integrity or intended identity.

- v. AI Coordinators must inform learners that they must take examinations based on

the **payment receipt**. Hence, learners should exercise greater caution when making examination fee payments.

- vi. **Subject code alterations in the ENR are not permissible.** Subjects for which fees have been paid cannot be substituted with subjects for which fees have not been paid. No corrections/alterations are permitted in subject codes.
- vii. Validation Rules for the declaration of a pass in intermediate and SSC are available on the website.
- viii. AI Coordinators must provide the District Educational Officers with the fee-paid details/reports/lists for each session, including those without fines, with a Rs 25/- fine, and with a Rs 50/- fine, upon the conclusion of each spell.
 - a. Check List for submission of Fee Paid List
 - b. Print a copy of the 'Fee paid list' of regular and eligible failed learners separately.
 - c. Print copy of Fee not paid list of regular and eligible failed Learners separately
 - d. AI-wise summary statement of regular and eligible failed candidates.
 - e. TOC list along with original second-year intermediate failed marks memo/SSC State Board failed marks memo (2024-2025).
 - f. PH Learners list along with the application of the candidate and Xerox copy of the Medical Certificate issued by the competent authority attested by the DEO. Failure to submit the Xerox copy of the Medical Certificate attested by the DEO entails the cancellation of PH and is considered as a general candidate.
 - g. The fee paid and Not paid list duly carrying out corrections viz., Bio-data as per the SSC pass certificate/ other valid documents as prescribed in admission guidelines. Xerox copies of the supported documents/certificates should be enclosed. In the case of the mother's name, a Xerox copy of the Ration card/AADHAR Card should be enclosed to support the claim. **No Corrections will be considered without supporting documents.** No further correspondence will be entertained.
 - h. Submit the following documents for learners who have passed all subjects but wish to pursue improvement within one year of course completion must participate in all papers, including both theory and practical components. Additionally, learners should have agreed to nullify their earlier performance. They are granted a maximum of two chances during this period, and they are required to forfeit their previous performance in the passed papers.
 - i. Manuscript the Nominal Rolls ,ii.Declaration of the candidate ,iii.Cancelled pass certificate and migration cum TC with the signature of the candidate duly attested by the AI Coordinator.

- The examination fee must be submitted in the form of a Demand Draft payable to the Director of TOSS, Hyderabad. For Intermediate exams, the fee is Rs.350/- per theory subject and Rs.150/- per practical subject. For SSC exams, the fee is Rs.200/- per theory subject and Rs.100/- per practical subject.

All AI Coordinators are requested to adhere strictly to the aforementioned guidelines and instructions without deviation, ensuring widespread dissemination at their respective levels. Further, they are requested to guide learners in submitting the examination fee directly through www.telanganaopenschool.org or Meeseva/TGOnline centers.
